

Narconon Drug Rehabilitation Overview of Statistics and Results 2009

- Scientologists support Narconon, a drug-free rehabilitation program utilizing L. Ron Hubbard's breakthroughs in handling drug addiction.
- Narconon was founded in 1966 when an inmate in the Arizona State Prison read one of L. Ron Hubbard's books on Scientology and wrote to Mr. Hubbard asking for his help to kick a life-long drug habit. Since then, tens of thousands of people have graduated the Narconon program.
- Their centers have a documented success rate of **75 percent of graduates never** returning to lives of addiction.
- Today, Narconon operates from its premiere drug rehabilitation facility at Lake Arrowhead in Oklahoma, which also serves as a training center for drug rehabilitation professionals and volunteers from around the world.
- Narconon operates a network of 185 groups in 47 nations, including 59 residential facilities.
- Narconon drug educators have lectured to 17 million students.
